



Commercial Pilot Certificate

NOTE: costs of ratings (Commercial Pilot Certificate) will **vary** depending on an individual's pace and training needs. This estimate assumes that the candidate holds an instrument rating and is within close range of the 120-hour total time requirement. These breakdowns reflect a minimum.

Ground Instruction (35 Hours)	\$3,850.00
FAA Practical Test (Aircraft Rental Approx. 1.5 Hours)	\$607.50
