Instrument Training is done in a (*Cirrus SR20*) The rate is (\$455.00/hour) and instruction is \$110.00/hour.

Requirements

35 Hours of actual or simulated instrument time

• 35 Hours of instrument flight training from an authorized instructor in the aircraft category for which the instrument rating is sought.

- 3 Hours of preparation instruction within 60 days prior to the practical exam
- Note: A maximum of 14 hours may be performed in a flight simulator or flight training device with an authorized instructor
- IFR 250 NM cross country flight along airways or ATC-directed routing
- Includes an instrument approach at each airport; and
- Three different kinds of approaches with the use of navigation systems
- Pass FAA written examination.
- Pass FAA check ride.
