

## Commercial Pilot Certificate

NOTE: costs of ratings (**Commercial Pilot Certificate**) will vary depending on an individual's pace and training needs. This estimate assumes that the candidate holds an instrument rating and is within close range of the 120-hour total time requirement. These breakdowns reflect a minimum.
